<p>4 – Graph accurately represents your problem, including labeled title, scales and axes.</p> <p>3 – Graph accurately shows relationship between variables in your problem, but some part of the labeling is missing or inaccurate.</p> <p>2 – Graph has mistakes in showing the relationship between variables in your problem.</p> <p>1 – Graph does not represent your problem.</p> <p>0 – Graph is missing entirely.</p>	<p>4 – Table accurately shows a relationship between variables and includes labeled input and output.</p> <p>3 – Table accurately shows a relationship between variable, but labeled input and output may be missing.</p> <p>2 – Table has mistakes in showing the relationship between variables.</p> <p>1 – Table does not show a relationship between variables.</p> <p>0 – Table is missing entirely.</p>	
<b>EQUATION</b>	<b>COMMUNICATION</b>	
<p>4 – Equation accurately shows a relationship including 2 variables.</p> <p>3 – Equation accurately shows a relationship but variables may be used incorrectly.</p> <p>2 – Equation has mistakes in showing a relationship between variables.</p> <p>1 – Equation does not show a relationship between variables.</p> <p>0 – Equation is missing entirely.</p>	<p><b>QUESTIONS</b></p> <p>4 – has three thoughtful, relevant questions.</p> <p>3 – has two thoughtful, relevant questions and one irrelevant question.</p> <p>2 – has two thoughtful, relevant questions and one missing question.</p> <p>1 – has one thoughtful, relevant question and two missing questions OR has three irrelevant questions.</p> <p>0 – questions missing.</p>	<p><b>ANSWERS</b></p> <p>4 – has complete and correct answers.</p> <p>3 – has answers with minimal errors.</p> <p>2 – has answers to questions with substantial errors.</p> <p>1 – has answers to questions with major errors.</p> <p>0 – answers missing.</p>
