## **For Loops**

The type of loop used when the number of times the loop must execute is known. We use a variable to count the number of times we have gone around the loop.

## **Example uses**

1. Create a variable called i and assign its start value. Here, it is 0.

```
for (int i = 0) {
```

2. Set the condition that will keep the loop running.

```
for (int i = 0; i < 10) {</pre>
```

**3**. Specify that we will increment **i** each time.

```
(for (int i = 0; i < 10; i++) {</pre>
```

4. Create a loop that will print "Hello" 10 times.

```
for (int i = 0; i < 10; i++) {
    System.out.pritnln("Hello");
}</pre>
```
